Sam's Hike 2nd January 2010

Due to the heavy snow fall the intended walk from Mam Tor car park was rearranged to start from Hazel Grove car park.

10 walkers set off from the car park turning left onto the A6 and walk to the entrance to Hazel Grove Golf Club. We went left here up the drive past the club house and across the golf course to the road. We crossed the road and took the footpath to Middlewood Way. We crossed Middlewood Way to follow the path opposite which took us to the A6 near the Royal Oak pub. We crossed the A6 and walked up the road passed the old Middlewood tip to the canal where we were met by Geoff, who had walked from Disley due to the heavy snow. We continued along the tow path to the next bridge which we went over to follow the footpath passing Middlecale Farm and Platt Wood farm to John Harrop's signpost. We turned right here and followed the footpath over fields to Lyme Park where we had lunch at the car park.

After lunch we walked along the road to Four Winds then passed Haresteads Farm to the canal. We turned right along the tow path to the footpath on the left to Prince's Wood. This is where Geoff left us to continue along the tow path to High Lane and back to Disley. We continued along the footpath to cross Middlewood Way and a road to Prince's Wood. At a path junction we went right and at the next junction right again. We then took the path on the left to Norbury Hollow and up to Mill lane. We then walked to the A6 turned and turned left back to the car park.

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Respect all facilities and all officials -Referees, Coaches, Managers & Administration Staff
2. Play fairly and honestly at all times.
3. No verbal abuse, bad language or foul play both on and off the field of play
4. Respect all players – both your team mates & opposition, applaud all good pieces of play

SPECTATORS, COACHES, MANAGERS AND PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Read and abide by all the points in the *Players Code of Conduct*
2. All spectators from both teams must remain behind pitch Netting
3. Help encourage and support all children, praise fair play and good behavior
4. Do not shout instructions to players, the coach will provide this information – Too much information confuses the player and spoils the enjoyment of participation
5. Accept all decision made by match officials
6. Do not pressure players. Effort and performance are important, not the result!
7. Display patience – Children are not mini-adults. Do not expect too much either physically or mentally. Fun and enjoyment are paramount to the child's development
